In the Garden

Journal Topics

- ~ Create a list of your favorite veggies with drawings

Lessons

- ~ **Planting in the Garden**- working in teams, students can begin to plan their garden in preparation for planting vegetables once the soil is ready. Students can assist with soil preparation.
- ~ **Introduction to Watering the Garden**- Students can learn that plants need water just like people and animals need water.
- ~ **Seed Starting**- Students can learn how to start seeds
- ~ **Searching the Garden Safely**- As a class, students can create "garden tips" that will teach and reinforce appropriate garden behavior.

Activities

- ~ **Read**: Choose a Book of the Month and read to your students in the garden and discuss
- ~ **Exploration**: Create a garden scavenger hunt, having students search for colors, shapes, types of plants, insects or just something beautiful!
- ~ **Math**: Have the students calculate the area and perimeter of the garden. What could be planted given a particular spacing?
- ~ **Art**: Create your classroom garden sign
- ~ **Taste**: Taste and compare different varieties of apples
